

Lalu Table Lamp

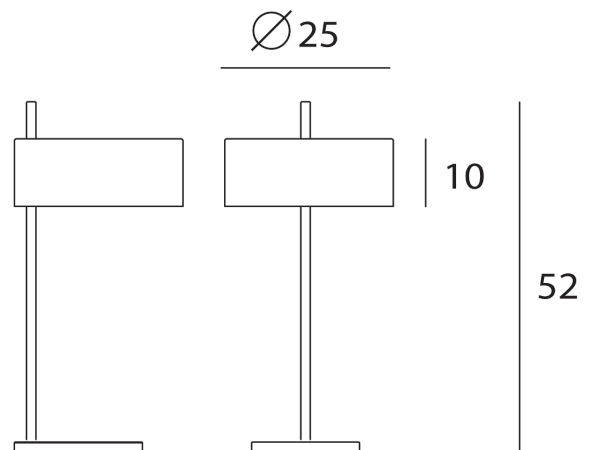

"Lalu" is a small island in Sun Moon Lake with holy significance to the indigenous Taiwanese peoples - the Thao. Much larger in earlier times, Lalu Island separated Sun Moon Lake into a crescent moon shape and round sun shape, giving the lake its name. This amity of sun and moon inspires the design of the Lalu Table Lamp. A white mouth-blown glass shade is complimented by a black steel frame and base, creating a harmonious contrast in both finish and material.
